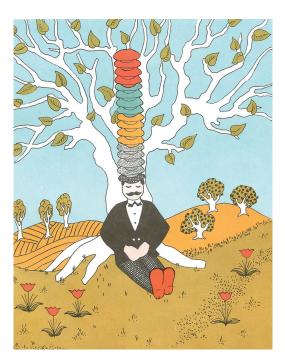
Caps Task
