About Teaching . . .

4. What challenges did you encounter in the implementation of the (open/tiered/parallel) task?
5. In what ways did the use of (open/tiered/parallel) tasks allow you to observe and support student thinking?
6. What about adapting tasks do you want to remember in terms of planning such tasks? Implementing such tasks?
