Student Interviews About Behavior

Encourage your mentee to interview students who are showing recurring misbehavior in the classroom. The mentee needs to come from a place of respect and tell the student that these behaviors are not acceptable, but also share that he wants to change the behavior. These personal conferences allow the teacher to look into the student's eyes so the student can share.

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1. Why are you behaving this way in the classroom?	
2. How can I help you?	
By taking the time to meet alone, the student's voice can be heard.
