## Identifying Your Talent Potential

The survey questions relate to specific aptitudes or abilities that can be developed. *Note:* This is not a complete list of aptitudes! You likely have others not on this survey.

1. Check any questions you rated as **often** true about you. These are evident strengths.
2. Next, check the questions you rated as **sometimes**. These are areas of potential growth.
3. If you checked **seldom** to a question, that doesn't mean that you don't have the aptitude. Perhaps through new experiences you will discover and develop this talent as well.
