




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1. What did you read and retell (or summarize) at the Partner Reading station today? Was it fiction or nonfiction? What did you include?

  3. Read a summary you wrote at the Partner Reading station today.


**TS1**

  3. What did you learn about a topic from two informational texts you read at the Partner Reading station? What information did you find in both texts? What else did you learn from one book that wasn't in the other?


**TS2**
