| Two groups: two teach same content                              | Whole-group seating area   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Carpeted area</li><li>• Chart easel, whiteboard, etc.</li><li>• Interactive whiteboard</li><li>• Computer with projector</li><li>• Seating arranged in horseshoe or circle</li></ul>                                       |

| Multiple groups: two monitor/teach                              | Areas designated for small groups and center or station learning | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Establish areas of the room for each learning station</li><li>• Have baskets for needed materials</li><li>• Provide portable box or folder-type centers that can be easily adapted to different classroom spaces</li></ul> |
