TIPS
Define important words/concepts upfront
Model the behavior you want to see in your partner
Find a source of information you can both rely on
Ask questions to find understanding and invite conversation
Reveal ignorance of ignorance
Mirror/Synthesize
Avoid certainty, and avoid questions and phrases that imply certainty
