## **HANDOUT 4.2A** Reading Path Activity I

## **Purpose**

- To record your movements as you read to recreate the text you have mentally put together as you made sense of all the material you come across
- To be conscious of how rules of notice are used to attract our attention, keep it, and lead it down particular paths

Although you may find this painstaking, it's like an investigator recreating an incident to see it better. Use the writing frame example to get started.
