

HANDOUT 7.1A Who's the Best Role Model?

Each of the following scenes features someone who could be considered a role model. Read each scene carefully and then rank them from the one who you think is the best role model (1) to the person who is the worst role model (4). Make sure you can support your decisions. You'll be talking about your rankings in small groups, and then we'll be sharing them as a class. Make sure that you're ready to explain the evidence on which you are basing your judgments and why that evidence affected your ranking.

1. Marissa was one of the first women to make it big in reggaeton. She was a real inspiration to both women and men trying to break into the business. She started with nothing, and now she has a worldwide following. But with fame and money came problems. Lots of them. Her marriage failed because she was so devoted to her music that she had time for nothing else. She's in the midst of a drug rehab that seems to be working but it's early yet. She's alienated from her family because they think she should be doing more good, not to them (she's always been very generous to her family with her money) but to the community. But the music keeps getting better and more and more young women are trying to follow her lead.
