Articles	A word that precedes a noun to show whether it is specific (definite: <i>that</i> cat) or general (indefinite: <i>a</i> cat)	the, a, an, this, that
Prepositions	Describes the relationship between words in terms of direction, time, location, or space	under, inside, in front of, in back of, above, below, through, within, for, at
