

INFOGRAPHIC RUBRIC: ASSESSING AN INFOGRAPHIC

DEFINITIONS OF RATINGS

Highly developed: Provides convincing evidence that demonstrates depth and knowledge of content and explains connections made to real-world situations. Goes beyond the expectations.

Developed: Provides evidence that demonstrates understanding of the content that meets the criteria but lacks the depth of knowledge and makes general connections without explanations. All components required are met.

Emerging: Provides partial evidence that demonstrates the required depth in all criteria of the assignment. Response may be unsupported, flawed, or missing elements.

Initial: Lacks the evidence required in all criteria of the assignment. Evidence presented may be minimal, unsupported, inadequate, or missing.
