Proof:

a lot = a whole lot

Ex:

(a whole lot)

There was a lot of food at the party.

PRACTICE THE CONVERSATION:

A: Please read me the sentence.

B: *There was a lot of food at the party.*

A: Great! How did you spell *a lot*?

B: A . . . space . . . l-o-t.

A: Space? Isn't it one word? A-l-o-t?

B: No.

A: Yes, I believe it's one word.

A: Can you prove that?

B: *There was a whole lot of food at the party.*

A: Oh! You're so right! *A lot* is two words.
