Proof:

lay = put

Ex:

He should ^(put) lay the candle on the table.

PRACTICE THE CONVERSATION:

A: Please read the sentence.

B: *He should lay the candle on the table.*

A: Oh no, you mean *lie the candle on the table*, right?

B: No, I do not.

A: How can you prove that?

B: *He should put the candle on the table.*
