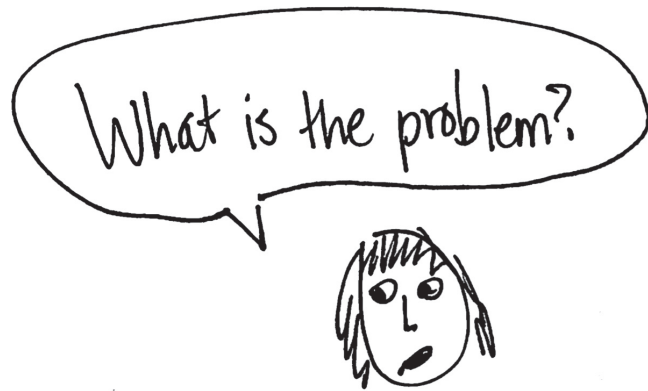


Question marks inside quotations



Ex:

(? inside ")

"What's the problem?" she
asked.

She asked, "What's the
problem?"

PRACTICE THE CONVERSATION:

A: Read the sentence, please.

B: "What's the problem?" she asked.

A: Why is that question mark inside the quotation marks?

B: Well . . . everything inside the quotation marks is what someone said out loud.

A: Uh-huh . . .

B: And everything she said is just like in the word bubble.

A: Uh huh . . .

B: And when you see it in the word bubble, her words are a question that ends with a question mark.

A: Uh huh . . .

B: So the quote ends with a question mark and the quotation marks go after it.

A: Good!
