
Capitalize the first word in a quotation

EX:



He whispered in her ear,

(1st word in quote)
"They saw your tweet."

PRACTICE THE CONVERSATION:

A: Will you please read the sentence?

B: He whispered in her ear, "They saw your tweet."

A: Great. But why is the word *they* capitalized?

B: It's the beginning of the quote.

A: Yes, but it's not the beginning of the whole sentence.

B: True, but that doesn't matter. All quotes start with capital letters.

A: Aha. Nice work.
