Noun + verb

Proof:

(noun) + (verb)

Boys laugh.

PRACTICE THE CONVERSATION:

A: Will you please read the two-word sentence?

B: *Boys laugh.*

A: Great. Is the second word a verb?

B: Yeppers.

A: Can you prove it?

B: I laugh, you laugh, he laughs.

A: Perfect. Is the first word a noun?

B: It sure is.

A: Can you prove that?

B: A boys, the boys, some boys.

A: It works perfectly in at least one of those, so it's definitely a noun. Right?

B: Right.

A: Well that's a perfect little two-word sentence. Thank you!

B: You're welcome.
