stand for nouns

EX:

(subj. pronoun) (obj. pronoun) We don't care about them very much.

B: We don't care about them very much.

A: Great. We have two pronouns. What are they?

B: We and them.

A: Yes. Let's hear what happens if you switch those words. Read that, please?

B: Them don't care about we very much.

B: *We.*
