Definition:

stand for nouns

Ex:

(subj. pronoun)      (obj. pronoun)  
We don't care about them  
very much.

- B:** *We and them.*

- A:** Your ear knows the difference between subjects and objects. Which one of those pronouns is used as a subject?
- B:** *We.*
- A:** Right. And which is used as an object?
- B:** *Them.*
- A:** Exactly. So if you wanted to switch them correctly, how would it sound?
- B:** *They don't care about us very much.*
- A:** Good work!
