Definition:

get attention or show excitement

Ex:

(interjection)

Uh oh! I don't know what

(interjection)

happened, honey.

PRACTICE THE CONVERSATION:

A: Read the sentence, please.

B: *Uh oh! I don't know what happened, honey.*

A: Do you see a couple of interjections?

B: I do. *Uh oh!* and *honey*.

B: *I don't know what happened.*
