Definition:

get attention or show excitement

EX:

(interjection)

<u>Uh oh!</u> I don't know what

(interjection)

happened, honey.

PRACTICE THE CONVERSATION:

A: Read the sentence, please.

B: Uh oh! I don't know what happened, honey.

A: Do you see a couple of interjections?

B: I do. *Uh oh!* and *honey.*

A: Will you read the sentence without them?
