

Direct objects

action verb + what?

Ex:

My daughter writes songs.
(d.o. = what?)

PRACTICE THE CONVERSATION:

A: Read the sentence please.

B: *My daughter writes songs.*

A: Great. What's the verb in this sentence?

B: *Writes.*

A: Can you prove that?

B: Sure. I write, you write, he writes.

A: Yes! So how do we find the direct object?

B: We say the verb and *what*. So . . . writes what?

A: And?

B: *Songs* is the direct object.

A: Perfect.
