QAR Strategy	Category	Description
Right There	Text explicit	The question is asked using words from the text, and the answer is directly stated in the reading.
Think and Search	Text implicit	The questions are derived from the text and require the reader to look for the answer in several places and to combine the information.
Author and You	Script and text implicit	The question has the language of the text, but in order to answer it, readers must use what they understand about the topic. The answer cannot be found directly in the text, but the text can provide some information for formulating an answer. The information is implied, and the reader infers what the author meant by examining clues in the text.
On My Own	Script implicit	The question elicits an answer to come from the reader's own prior knowledge and experiences. The text may or may not be needed to answer the question.

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
