There is no evidence of interest or growth in the reader. The notebook is lacking notes as a whole and is largely disorganized.</p>	<p>Notebook entries include opinions and summaries with little evidence from the book. Little to no questions are raised about the books being read.</p> <p>There is little to no interest in reading or evidence of growth in the reader.</p> <p>Entries are missing from the table of contents and actual body of the notebook.</p>	<p>Notebook entries reflect a solid understanding of the book, as well as theories and ideas regarding character and theme that are supported with ample evidence from the book.</p> <p>Questions may be raised and/or answered by the reader.</p> <p>Entries may also show evidence of interest in reading and/or growth by the reader. All entries are completed and organized according to the table of contents.</p>	<p>Notebook entries indicate an excellent understanding of the books.</p> <p>All ideas and writings about character and theme are supported with evidence from the test, as well as follow-up thinking and explanations.</p> <p>Entries reflect a strong interest in reading as well as evidenced growth across the marking periods.</p> <p>All entries are completed and organized according to the table of contents.</p>
