Four Corners (20–30 minutes)

STEP	FACILITATION TIP	NOTES
<p>Prework: Place signs in the four corners of the room that read:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Agree2. Strongly Agree3. Disagree4. Strongly Disagree		
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Explain that you will make a statement and give participants time to think. When you say, "GO," participants will move to the corner of the room that accurately reflects how they feel about the statement and then have a conversation with the participants in their corner.		
<ol style="list-style-type: none">2. Make some simple statements such as:<ul style="list-style-type: none">• I like to do things outdoors• I like to create things• I like to try new foods• I like to play sports	Wait for participants to go to their corner. Allow time for all to share.	
<ol style="list-style-type: none">3. Ask, what did you learn about your colleagues?		

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
