

	<b>WE USE WORDS TO BUILD EACH OTHER UP</b> We only use words to lift each other up. We do not use words that bring each other down.	3
	<b>WE RESPECT EACH OTHER'S PHYSICAL SPACE</b> Respecting physical space is keeping our hands to ourselves. Respecting physical space is respecting each other's privacy. Respecting physical space is not hitting or kicking. Respecting physical space is not invading privacy.	4
	<b>WE SOLVE PROBLEMS CALMLY</b> Solving problems calmly is having a soft voice. Solving problems calmly is looking for a win-win solution. Solving problems is not yelling or arguing. Solving problems is being okay with compromise.	5
