Precision Requests



The trick is to be assertive, (but patient), and always follow through.



GENERAL REQUEST
"It's time for bed."



PLEASE REQUEST
"[Child's name], PLEASE get ready for bed."



NEED REQUEST
"[Child's name], you NEED to get ready for bed."

Wait 3-5 seconds after every request.

Stand 3-5 feet from your child.

Make eye contact with your child for both the PLEASE and the NEED requests.

If the child does not comply to the NEED request, physically prompt the student to complete the request. Have a consequence in mind when your child DOES comply to the request and when your child DOES NOT comply.
