Tips for Mystery Mathematicians

- Reach out to parents if they do not volunteer.
- Encourage parents from other countries to share differences in the way they learned mathematics compared to their children.
- Be flexible and encourage any mode of participation, even if a parent feels most comfortable sharing a game or experience by writing about it. Read it aloud to the class and honor that parent's contribution.
- Invite parents to be Mystery Mathematicians after you have begun to build strong relationships with parents and cultivated trust around mathematics.
