

7.10 Protocol for Reflecting on Lesson Study

Time	Description of Step	Notes
5 minutes	Instructor's Observations The instructor restates the learning outcomes for the lesson and comments on any aspect of teaching the lesson such as the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student engagement • Clarity of instruction • Any insights from the teacher's perspective 	
10-15 minutes	Share Observation Data Each observing teacher <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • individually presents the data gathered and • explains what these data reveal about student learning. 	
15 minutes	Discussion of Data and Learning After each team member has presented their data, they all discuss any of the following questions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What are the implications for our teaching and learning from these data? • What new understandings or questions do we now have based on the data? • What did we learn from the lesson study cycle in general? Note: Build on each other's ideas and refer to the observational data or student work gathered during the discussion. Facilitator will make notes of key points raised.	
3-5 minutes	Closing Comments Facilitator <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • provides a synopsis of the discussion and • schedules the next lesson study. 	Next Steps for Instruction
