

7.9 Overview of Lesson Study

Step	Approximate Time	Description
Before the Lesson Co-plan	45 minutes or one planning period	Teams of teachers meet to plan a lesson for a lesson study. Part 1: Generate a question about teaching and learning (3-5 min.). Part 2: Co-plan (35 min.). Teachers contribute ideas and strategies to support the learning outcome and address the guiding question. Part 3: Data (3-5 min.). Teachers decide how they will gather student-centered data about the question.
During the Lesson Teach and Observe	45 minutes or one class period	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> One teacher delivers the co-planned lesson. Observers focus on gathering student-centered data.
After the Lesson Collaborative Reflection	45 minutes or one planning period	The lesson study team meets to <ul style="list-style-type: none"> share student-centered data, reflect on student learning, and determine next steps for instruction.
