

## 5.7 Types of Graphic Scaffolds





Charts		<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A chart displays numerical data that can be represented in a diagram, table, or graph.</li></ul>
Graphs		<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Graphs, a subset of charts, communicate numerical information by showing how numbers change and one number impacts another.</li></ul>
Tables		<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Tables store and organize a data set in columns and rows.</li></ul>
Timelines		<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Timelines visualize a sequence of events.</li></ul>

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
