STEPS IN INITIAL DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS	KEY QUESTIONS TO ASK OURSELVES
<p>1. Collect evidence for student learning based on agreed-upon learning targets</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How are we assessing both content attainment and language development of our multilingual learners?
<p>2. Organize data and prepare for collaborative discussions</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How do we know that our students are successful?
<p>3. Identify patterns in student learning</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What trends are emerging for different groups of students?
<p>4. Align student needs and interests to upcoming unit goals</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How do we coplan to ensure all students are growing and making progress? • Have we attended to our students' characteristics, including their languages, cultures, and experiences?
