### 1: IDEAL STATE

The Collective Efficacy Cycle comes to a close by meeting **all** of the following criteria.

### 2: DEVELOPING

The Collective Efficacy Cycle comes to a close by meeting **most** (50–99%) of the success criteria.

### 3: STARTING OUT

The Collective Efficacy Cycle comes to a close by meeting **some** (0–49%) of the success criteria.

#### Team members

- Gather information from students about their learning experience
- Evaluate the impact of the evidence-based practice by analyzing multiple sources of data
- Determine if the cycle was a mastery experience
- Identify future areas for professional learning
- Plan a gallery walk using artifacts from the cycle and invite colleagues to view, ask questions, and comment
