Was worked in the hosiery mill for a long time and, well, then we finally moved back to More of the country. But me and my sister Molly descriptu finally went back up there in 1910 and I went to work in the silk mill. Molly went to work in the hosiery mill . . . we worked 12 DUL hours a day for 50 cents. When paydays ws./ come around, I drawed three dollars. That each day was for six days, 72 hours. I remember I lacked 50 cents having enough to pay my board. I almost had enough to pay my food
