## **EQUITY TERMS**

Time required: 45 minutes

Materials required: For each participant, Courageous Conversation Journal and the worksheet that follows

- 1. Make a copy of the following worksheet for each participant.
- 2. Before the discussion begins, have all educators answer 1a, 2a, 3a, and 4a by writing down what they believe each of the following terms means:

Racism

Institutionalized racism

**Equity** 

Anti-racism

- 3. Ask for three to four volunteers to share with the entire group their personal definition of each term. Compare and contrast these definitions.
- 4. Share the definitions of each term based on what is presented in this chapter.
- 5. After the discussion, have each person answer 1b, 2b, 3b, and 4b by writing down a new definition of each term.
- 6. Divide all participants into small groups of three or four people. Have the groups discuss how their understanding of these terms has changed.
- 7. Bring the large group back together and allow people to share any conclusions.
- 8. Have the participants reflect on their personal learning and keep the worksheet in their journals for later reference.
