### Stories to Inspire and Guide School Leaders

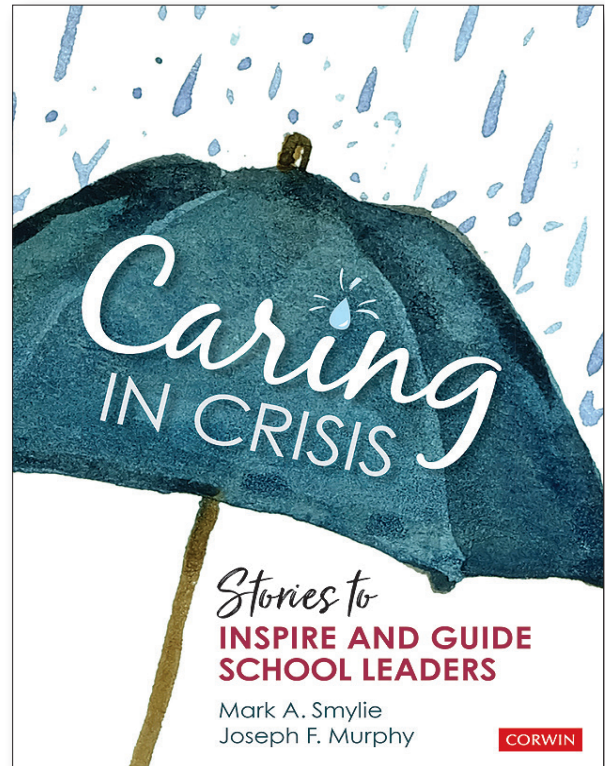
