Directions for Labeling

- 1. Label each mask you and your family member have in order to track the use and disposal of the masks. For example, if a person named Ho-Chieh Lin used his first mask for the first time, write down HCL-M1-l to represent his <name initials> and <masks one l> and <times of use>. If he used the same mask for the second time on a different day, write down HCL-M1-2. If he used his second mask for the first time, write down HCL-M2-1.
- 2. This system enables you to track the use of different types of masks that are used multiple times before disposal.
- **3.** Check with yourself and your family members on a daily basis.
- **4.** Sum up the use of masks at the end of the week.
