Compassion/ Introduction Story Time	Pre-K	Story Time	Use puppets to role play situations that demonstrate compassion.
Compassion/ Community Circle	I-3	Morning Meeting	Have a question that everyone answers, such as "When did a friend help you when you were sad?" to start a conversation about compassion.
Compassion/Heart Centered Breathing/ Long Deep Breathing	Pre-K	Morning Meeting, After Lunch or Recess, End of the Day	Give each student a pebble and ask them to place it on their belly. Have them watch it rise up as they breathe in and come down as they breathe out.
Compassion/ Community Circle	I-3	Morning Meeting	Have students form a circle and hold hands. Tell the students that you have love in your left hand. When you squeeze the hand of the person next to you, it passes the love on. Practice passing the love around the circle. Then, introduce the kindness you have in your right hand and pass that along in the opposite direction. Combine the two, passing love in one direction and kindness in the other.
