## EXAMPLES

### Goals for my teaching:

1. I will be reading a book at all times, just as I ask my students to do.
2. I will not give homework that has no purpose.
3. I will increase my use of rubrics.
4. I will be intentional about teaching content-area vocabulary terms.
5. I will seek student input on my teaching by using periodic surveys.

### Goals for our teaching team:

1. We will use at least three co-teaching structures per week.
2. We will meet once a week with data on every student and plan how to respond.
3. We will read one professional book together each semester.
4. We will explore the use of student-led conferences to be held on parent conference nights.
5. We will go to one professional conference together and bring back at least one innovative practice to our co-taught classroom.

### Student achievement goals:

1. Each semester we will have 75% or more of our students with a grade of C or above.
2. Our students will pass the state test at a rate of at least 10% higher than last year's class.
3. At least 80% of our students will be able to write an explanatory/informational text that meets or exceeds the proficient score on the state writing rubric.
4. At least 75% of our students will report that we are meeting their needs on a survey of our effectiveness.
5. We will use a pre- and posttest for every unit in social studies and will guarantee that each student scoring below 80% on the pretest will show at least 10% growth on the posttest.
