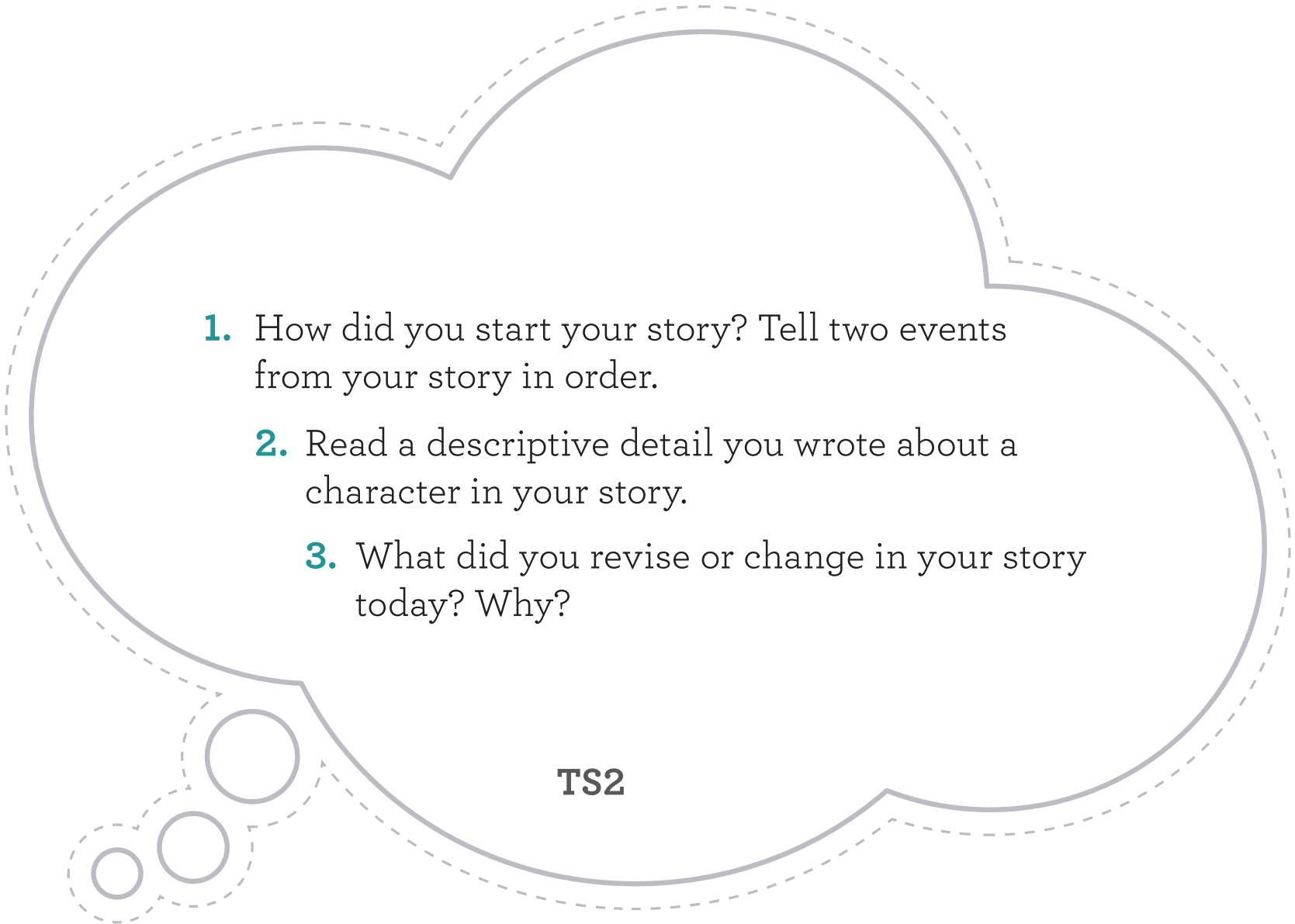


1. What did you write about at the Writing station today? How did you come up with your idea?

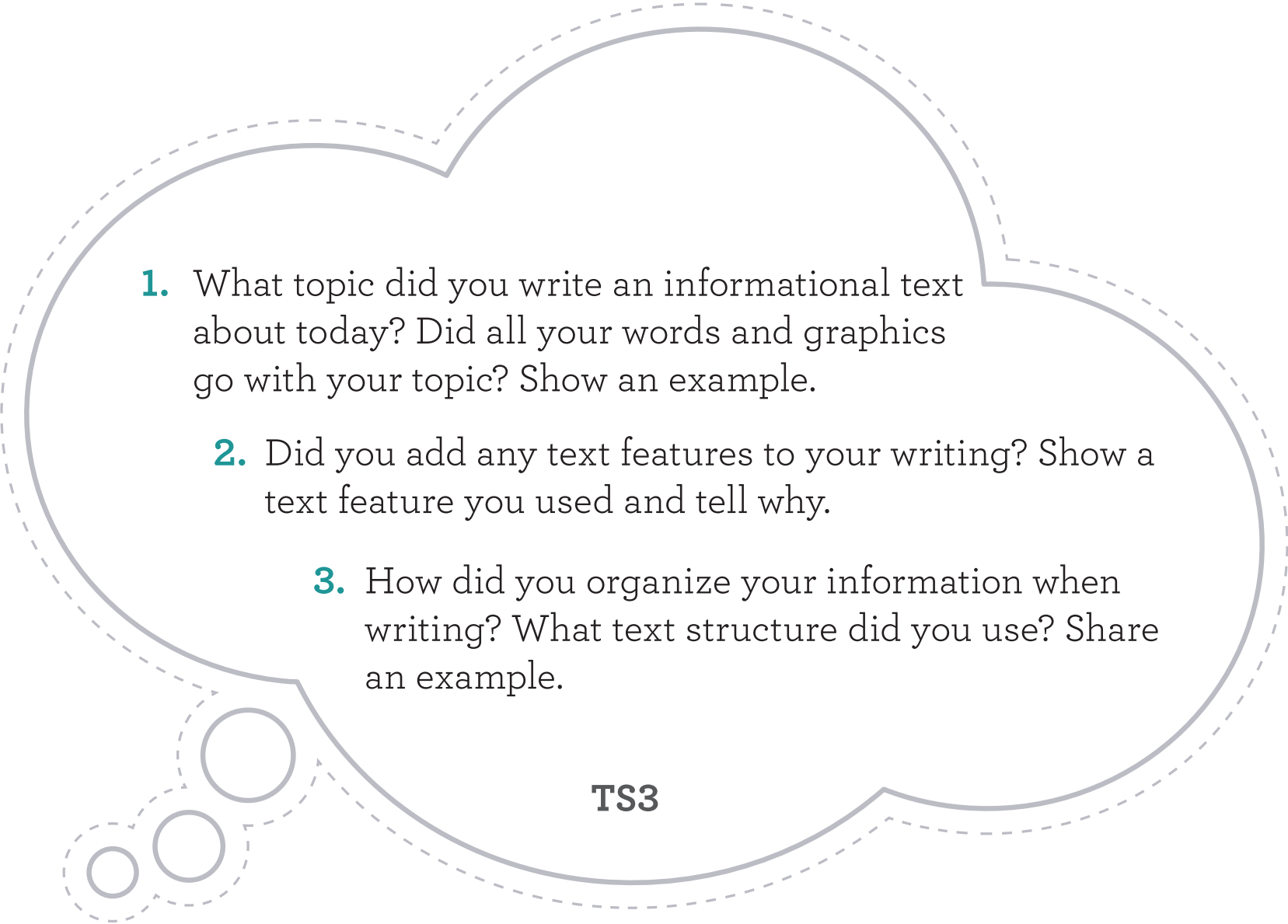
2. How did you plan your writing at the Writing station today? What did you use to get started?

3. Who was your audience for what you wrote today? Why did you write this piece?

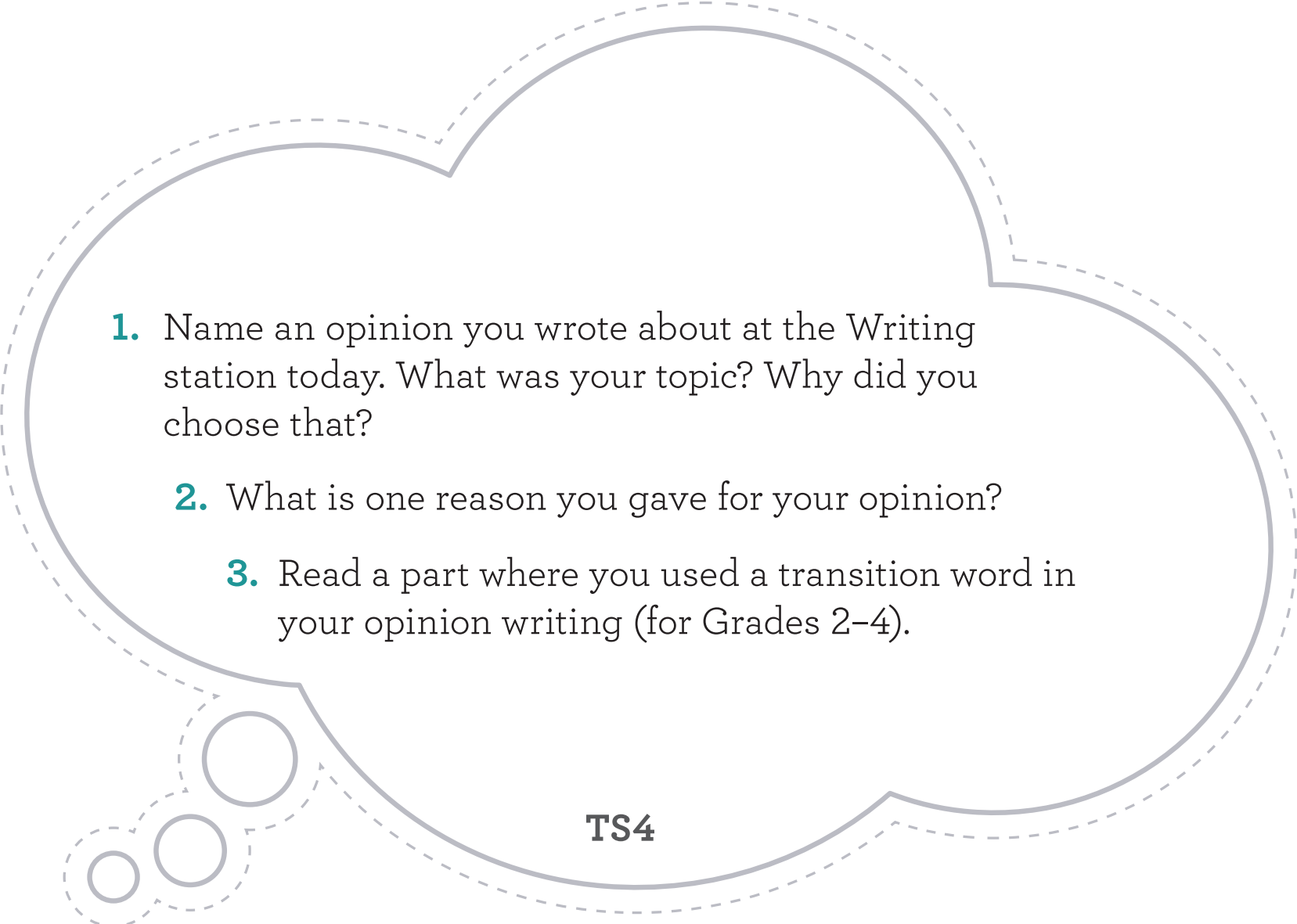
TS1

 3. What did you revise or change in your story today? Why?

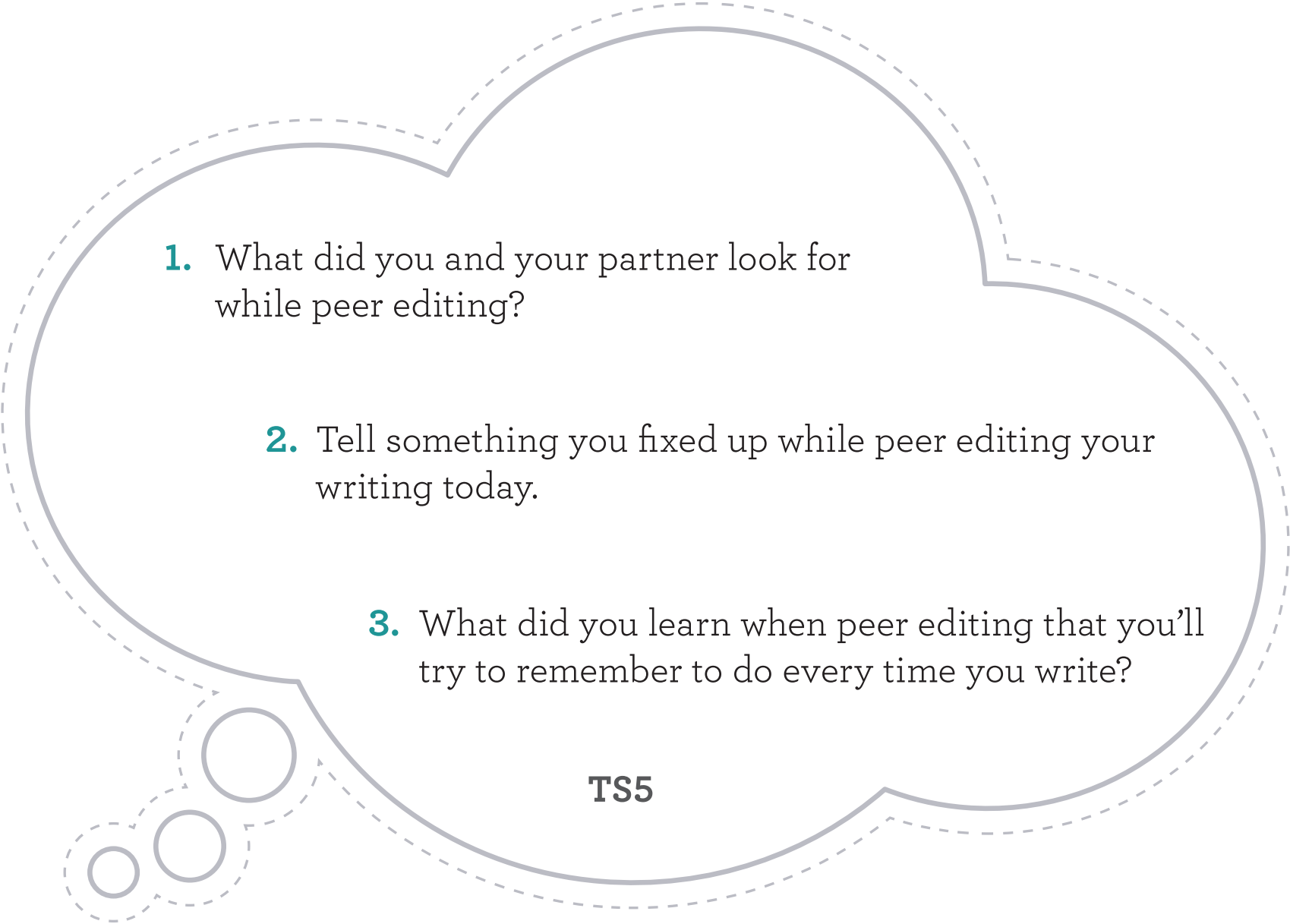
TS2
