Ideas for Multilingual Projects for Common Assessment, Standards, and Criteria for Success

Principals, coordinators, or directors may wish to share ideas for multilingual projects with grade-level teacher teams and, as a faculty, select one or two schoolwide projects per year based on a curricular focus or a current initiative for common assessment. Based on the selection of projects and using Resource 5.3 as a guide, each grade-level team can then select applicable standards in English and Spanish (as applicable) and craft criteria of success or adapt an existing rubric.
